Join us for Coding Club! This program is for children grades K-5; we'll have stations set up with different games and gadgets to teach coding skills!







Join us for Coding Club Junior! This program is for younger children, ages 3-6. We'll have stations set up with different games and toys to teach beginning coding skills!









